

2010 – 2011 Most Endangered Places

The Harvey House, 104 North First Street, Belen, Valencia County

- Built: 1910 By Santa Fe Railway; designed by Myron Church, Chicago architect.
- Mission Style typical of Santa Fe Railroad stations of the period.
- National Register, 10/28/1983; State Register, 10/1/1982; City of Belen Historic Landmark.
- Harvey House until 1939; reading room & rooming house for railway employees until 1980; reopened as Harvey House Civic Center in 1983 and is now housing Valencia County Historic Society Museum.
- Needs systems upgrades including HVAC & electrical; window repairs; correct roof drainage and repair water damage, eastern portal.
