

2010-11 Most Endangered Places

St. Catherine's Industrial Indian School, Santa Fe, Santa Fe County

- 3rd Indian school in NM; one of 25 between 1880-1900; St. Catherine's is the only one remaining in state.
- State register 2001; City of SF Landmark 2006; 19 buildings determined contributing & 11 eligible for National Register, 2010.
- Mission revival and pueblo revival styles; murals painted by students remain, especially fresco "Our Lady of Guadalupe of the Americas," by Edward O'Brien, in main building.
- Intact buildings represent almost 110 year history of school.
